PLEASE NOTE:

The Pavilion closes at 6:00pm Show Day. **Stewards only will have access between 6:00pm and 6:45pm. All exhibits will be handed to their respective owner at 6:45pm.**

Conditions:

1. **All exhibitors will pay the gate entrance fee.**
2. Entries and exhibits will be accepted by Chief Steward in the Pavilion between 9:00am & 5:00pm Wednesday before Show Day. Entries close after 5:00pm at the Office.
3. Exhibits must be in the hands of the stewards by 9.00am Thursday before Show Day.
4. All exhibits to be accompanied by an entry form.
5. Entries cannot be entered into more than one class.
6. **No entries to be removed from the needlework section by the exhibitor.**
7. **Needlework section closed to public and exhibitors at 6pm show day to enable the Stewards to prepare exhibits for collection. Collection to be made after 6:45pm on show day.**
8. **All entries will be given to the exhibitors by the stewards after 6:45pm on show day.**
9. **All exhibits to be signed for upon collection.**
10. **Limit of three entries per class by any one person.**
11. Points: 1st- 3 points, 2nd - 2 points, Highly Commended. In the event of a tie, points will be shared. No additional points for Champion Exhibits.
12. If, in the judges' opinion, an entry is not worthy of a prize, it will not necessarily be given one.
13. Exhibits which have won a first prize at a previous Jandowae Show cannot be exhibited again in the same class. Exhibits can be entered for two (2) years only.

HINTS:

- An article is something not worn. A garment is something worn. An item can be either. An outfit is two or more pieces to make a set.
- All cushion covers must be provided with insert.
- All work must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor, and must have been completed within the last two years, not to be soiled, laundered or worn, otherwise it will not be considered suitable for Show purposes.
- Exhibits cannot be entered or compete in more than one class.
- All classes in wool are to be wool or substitute.
- Entries in this section will not be accepted from exhibitors outside a radius of
- 50km of Jandowae unless exhibits are nominated through a local resident.
- This must include receipt ticketing and return to exhibitor, and for the purpose of this rule, a local resident shall be deemed to be a resident within 50km of Jandowae.
- No Responsibility, as regards to the above exhibits, in respect of their receipt, exhibition or subsequent dispatch, will be accepted by the Secretary or Section Steward.

1. Embroidery - hand work only
2. Duchess set - coloured embroidery - hand work only
3. Any other hand embroidery - small item
4. Cross stitch article - not picture
5. Item featuring chenille work
6. Apron – any style
7. Boys outfit - 1 or 2 piece
8. Boys shirt or Girls blouse
9. Girls frock - size 3 and over
10. Creative embroidery by machine - any article
11. Machine appliqued article or garment
12. Verandah Cushion
13. Purchased towel or hand towel decorated
14. Most attractive cushion
15. Toddlers frock - size 6 months - 2 years
16. Most attractive child's playsuit or sun frock
17. Two distinct pot holders
18. Any item in check fabric
19. Afternoon tea throw over
20. Blouse hanger – fabric
21. Sewn novelty article or soft toy
22. Hand towel fabric top
23. Any sewn Adults clothing item

- 24. Premmie Quilt with embroidery approx. 24" square
- 25. One-person exhibit - 3 distinct items
- 26. Table Runner must include embroidery
- 27. Tracksuit or leisure suit in fleecy fabric – any size
- 28. Garment in fleecy fabric
- 29. Any useful household item
- 30. Sewn bag or backpacks
- 31. Any other item not previously mentioned by person over 60 years
- 32. Any needlework by person over 80 years
- 33. a) Any other item sewn – not previously mentioned
b) 2025 Jandowae Show Theme Item and embroidery featuring "Boots and Bulldust"

NOVICE:

Exhibitors can enter for 2 years only

OPEN KNTTING:

All hand knitting unless otherwise specified

- 38. Adult pullover/cardigan in thick wool
- 39. Knitted centre 20-30cm – can have crochet edge
- 40. Child's garment up to 5 ply
- 41. Child's garment in thick wool
- 42. Pram cover
- 43. Infant's head wear or booties
- 44. Knitted scarf or adult beanie or beret
- 45. Any other knitted article not previously mentioned
- 46. Knitted rug
- 47. Any knitted item for charity
- 48. Tea cosy
- 49. Knitted toy

OPEN CROCHET:

- 50. Cushion cover sized 38-40 cm only
- 51. Hand towel – crochet top
- 52. Table centre – coarse work (30 cotton or under)
- 53. Table centre – fine work (40 cotton or over)
- 54. Duchess set
- 55. 2 crochet doilies – distinct and mounted. Under 30cm in diameter
- 56. Kitchen item (cotton) Hot Pot Pads, Tea Cosy etc
- 57. Crochet garment or article not already mentioned
- 58. Table centre – linen centre – crochet edge
- 59. Face washer – crochet edge
- 60. a) Knee rug – crochet up to 40 inches
b) Knee rug – crochet over 40 inches
- 61. Crochet coat hanger
- 62. Any other article in crochet cotton or wool not previously mentioned
- 63. Article in crochet cotton not previously mentioned by person over 60 years
- 64. Article in crochet cotton by person over 80 years

TEENAGE 15 - 18 YEARS

All work must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor, and must have been completed within the last two years. It is not to be soiled, laundered, or worn, otherwise it will not be considered suitable for Show purposes

- 69. Cushion – any type – made up
- 70. Sewn novelty article or soft toy

JUVENILE 12 – 14 YEARS

- 75. Purchased T-shirt, decorated transfer may be used
- 76. Article in crochet or knitting
- 77. Any article featuring hand embroidery
- 78. Machine sewn article
- 79. Sewn pencil case
- 80. Sewn novelty article or soft toy
- 81. Sewn item in recycled material
- 82. Sewn cushion cover
- 83. Any other article not mentioned

CHILDREN 10 – 11 YEARS

- 84. Any article featuring hand embroidery
- 85. Machine or hand sewn article
- 86. Scrunchie
- 87. Sewn novelty article or soft toy
- 88. Pencil case
- 89. Article in crochet or knitting
- 90. Cushion cover
- 91. Any other article not mentioned

CHILDREN UNDER 10 YEARS
