

PHOTOGRAPHY – SECTION 11

Entries may be submitted to the chief steward by post or in person to 58 High Street, Jandowae 4410.

Conditions:

- All exhibitors must reside within 50km of Jandowae.
- All entries must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor within 24 months prior to the date of the show, and have not been previously entered in the Jandowae Show.
- Juvenile class entrants must be under 18, but are not restricted to enter only the Juvenile Classes.
- Photos of exactly the same subject may not be entered in more than one class.
- All regular prints are to be 6x4", mounted on 20x15cm black cardboard using strong double sided tape.
- All enlargements are to be 8x6", mounted on 26x21cm black cardboard using strong double sided tape.
- Enhanced Photo (Class 24) only: This class requires two 6x4" photos, on the left (portrait) or the top (landscape) must be the "before enhancement" photo, ie as taken and without any editing or Photoshop alterations. This includes the full scene if the edited photo is cropped. The photo on the right (portrait) or bottom (landscape) must be the "after enhancement" photo. Enhancements may be as simple as adjusting colour and contrast to photo stacking to adding frames, flares or any other artistic enhancements desired. This class will be judged on the final effect and overall enhanced composition.
- Prints in frames or mounted as groups instead of individually will not be accepted as entries.
- Limit of 3 entries per class by any one person.
- All entries to be placed in a manila folder with the Photography Entry Form glued to the front.
- All entries must have the name and address of the exhibitor on the reverse side of all submissions.
- Any entry that does not comply with the above conditions may be disqualified.
- Awarding of prizes in any and all classes is at the judge's discretion, according to the standard of work.
- The judge's decision is final.
- COVID 19: In an effort to reduce unnecessary traffic within the pavilion during peak times the following changes are being implemented and are expected to remain in place hereforth.
 - Entries must be submitted by contacting the Chief Steward. Entries must now be submitted two weeks before the show to allow extra time for the judging process. Late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.
 - Entries may be collected from Sunday after Show Day by contacting the chief steward. Entries will not be handed back on show day as they had been in previous years. The chief steward reserves the right to dispose of any entries that have not been collected within two weeks after Show Day.
