Conditions of entry:

- **CHAMPION PAINTING:** will be judged from the winners of all sections (excluding 11, 12c, 13c, 14c & 15)
- **SALE OF ART:** Sale entries may be priced for sale – 15% to the Show Society. Chief Steward to make the sale.
- **ENTRIES DEADLINE: 5pm WEDNESDAY the week of the show. All exhibits must be delivered to the Show Secretary's office by 12pm THURSDAY or will be removed from competition.**
- **ENTRIES:** Maximum of two entries per person, per section.
- **FRAMING:** Entries must be properly framed (unless on canvas) with hanging cord or wire strong enough to hold weight of paintings. "D" Hooks are essential and entries must be able to be hung safely. Stewards reserve the right to reject unsafe exhibits
- **EXHIBITS** must be labelled on the back with Artist's name, address and phone number; Title of work, Medium of artwork; Class being entered and sale price or "Not for Sale". The Show ticket is to be attached to the front of the artwork
- **SIZE LIMIT:** Maximum 100cm x 100cm (NB Section: 6 abstract – Maximum 120cm x 120cm including frame).

- EXHIBITOR: Each Exhibit must be the original work of the exhibitor. Exhibits which have been entered in a previous Jandowae Show will not be eligible to compete. (NB: Original work means that the entry must not be copied, however the committee is not responsible for establishing authenticity).
- NOVICE SECTION: an artist ceases to be eligible to enter this section after winning a first prize anywhere.
- Artwork to be no more than three years old.
- No replication of work between sections by the same exhibitor.
- Wet Paint Work: will NOT be accepted

Special Notes:

- The Pavilion closes at 6:00pm Show Day. **Stewards only will have access between 6:00pm and 6:45pm.** All exhibits will be handed to their respective owner at 6:45pm.
- All reasonable care will be taken with each exhibit, but works are exhibited at the risk of the entrant. The Jandowae & District Show Society Inc. will not be liable for any loss or damage, should it occur.
- Should an exhibitor be unable to be present at conclusion of exhibition, art works can be stored safely at the Show Office to be collected after the show. Prior arrangement must be made with Show Secretary/Chief Steward.
- All cash prizes and trophies must be claimed within one month of the last day of the show. Trophies not claimed and prize money not collected by the date will be considered to have lapsed, and the amount will become a donation to the Show Society.
