PLEASE NOTE:

The Pavilion closes at 6:00pm Show Day. Stewards only will have access between 6:00pm and 6:45pm. All exhibits will be handed to their respective owner at 6:45pm.

Conditions:

- CHAMPION PAINTING: will be judged from the winners of all sections, except Special Section. Sale entries may be priced for sale – 15% to the Show Society. Chief Steward to make the sale.
- ENTRIES DEADLINE: 12pm THURSDAY before the show. Entries after this time will incur a \$2 penalty.
- ENTRIES: Maximum of two entries per person, per section.
- FRAMING: Exhibits must be properly framed and able to be hung safely. “D’ hooks are essential. Stewards reserve the right to reject exhibits considered unsafe.
- EXHIBITS must be labelled on the back with Artist’s name, address and phone number; Title of work, Medium of artwork; Class being entered and sale price or “Not for Sale”. The Show ticket is to be attached to the front of the artwork.
- SIZE LIMIT: Maximum 100cm x 100cm (NB Section: 6 abstract – Maximum 120cm x 120cm including frame).
- AGE: Artwork to be no more than three years old.
- EXHIBITOR: Each Exhibit must be the original work of the exhibitor. The Exhibits must NOT have been awarded a first prize at a previous Jandowae Show. (NB: Original work means that the entry must not be copied, however the committee is not responsible for establishing authenticity).
- No replication of work between sections by the same exhibitor.
- Wet Paint Work: will NOT be accepted.
- Colouring book page exhibits must be framed and under glass.
- NOVICE SECTION: an artist ceases to be eligible to enter this section after winning a first prize anywhere.
- All reasonable care will be taken with each exhibit but works shall at all times be at the risk of the entrant. No responsibility can be accepted for loss or damage to the exhibit.
- Should exhibitor be unable to be present at conclusion of exhibition, art works can be stored safely at the Show Office to be collected after the show. Prior arrangement would need to be made with Show Secretary/Chief Steward.
- Demounting exhibition 6:00pm. Art work will be handed to exhibitor at 6:15pm.
