PLEASE NOTE:

The Pavilion closes at 6:00pm Show Day. Stewards only will have access between 6:00pm and 6:45pm. All exhibits will be handed to their respective owner at 6:45pm.

This event will be running under a QLD Agricultural Shows and Showgrounds Industry COVIDSafe plan.

Changes to the schedule may need to be made by the committee at any time due to any circumstances.

Conditions:

- **All exhibitors will pay the gate entrance fee.**
- No Entry Fee – No Prize Money
- Entries and exhibits will be accepted by Chief Steward in the Pavilion between 9:00am & 3:00pm Thursday before Show Day. Entries close at 5:00pm (Office). Late entries will be displayed but not judged.
- If, in the judges' opinion, an entry is not worthy of a prize, it will not necessarily be given one.
- All exhibits to be accompanied by an entry form.
- Entries cannot be entered into more than one class.
- **No entries to be removed from the handicrafts section by the exhibitor.**
- **Handicrafts section closed to public and exhibitors at 6pm to 6:45pm show day to enable the Stewards to prepare exhibits for collection. Collection to be made after 6:45pm on show day.**
- **All entries will be given to the exhibitors by the stewards after 6:45pm on show day.**
- **All exhibits to be signed for upon collection.**
- **Limit of three entries per class by any one person.**
- All quilts to have a rod pocket to facilitate hanging.
- Cushion Covers to present with inserts.
- All work to be finished within the last 2 years. Older work can be accepted for display purposes.
- Points: 1st- 3points, 2nd - 2 points.
